






Janmashtami is celebrated as the birthday of Lord Krishna, one of the most powerful and famous reincarnations of lord Vishnu.



The activity was to represent their native state by wearing their traditional dress and speaking a few lines about the culture, tradition and cuisine of that particular place. This activity helped the students to know more about their as well as other states and their significance.

The students of class 4, were divided into different groups and were allotted different topics - 'Physical Divisions of India', 'Fundamental Duties', and 'Coastal States'. The students of each group came up with unique ideas to present their topic. This activity helped them to know more about these topics.

In India, climatic variations are wide between different parts of the country and so the patterns of traditional clothing vary depending on the climate there. The students of class 5 dressed up in different traditional Costumes representing different states, spoke few lines on the climatic conditions. They also mentioned the latitudes and longitudes position of the chosen state and the lifestyle of the people. The research and the presentation helped them to get acquainted about the detail knowledge of different states of India.
