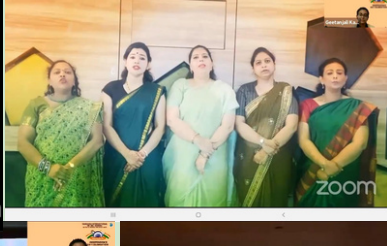

# INDEPENDENCE DAY

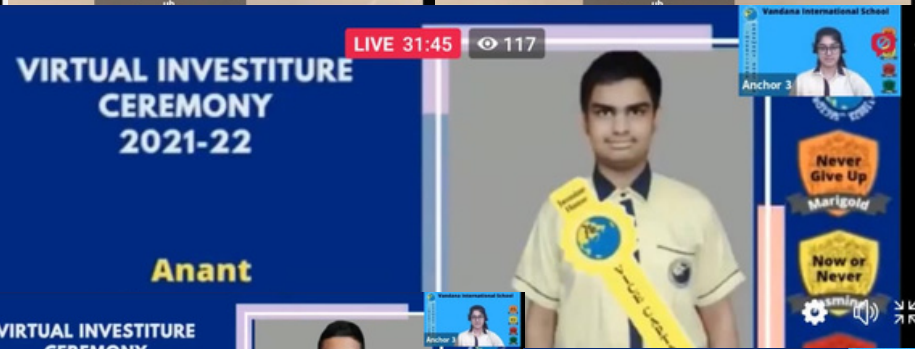
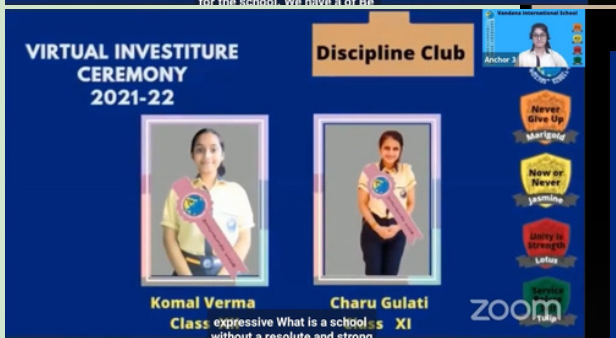
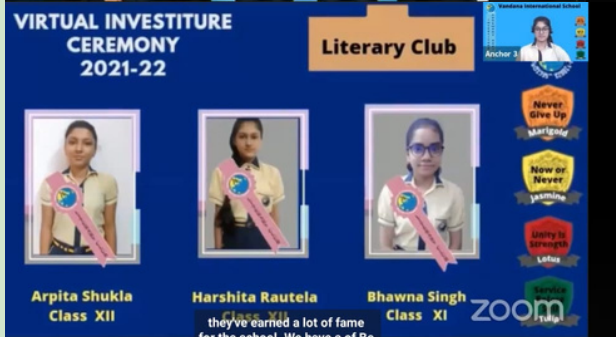

# SYNERGIA 2021

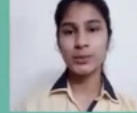
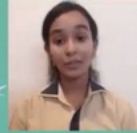

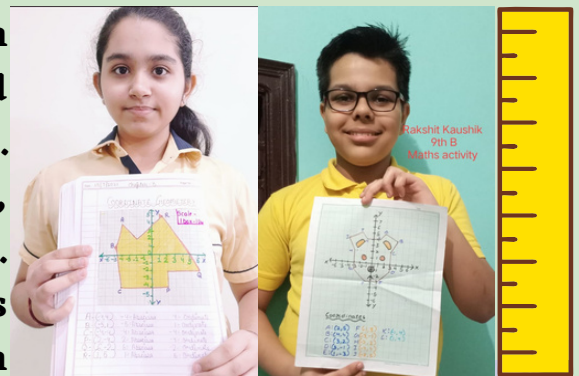


## Maths

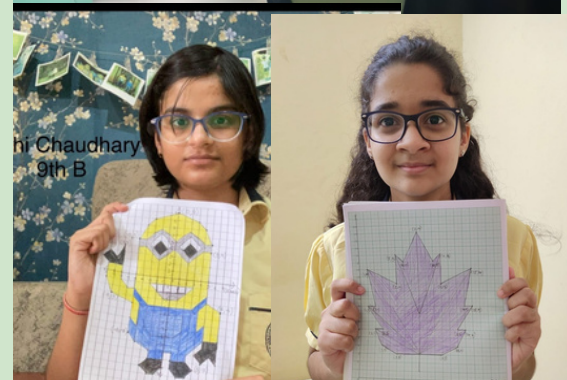
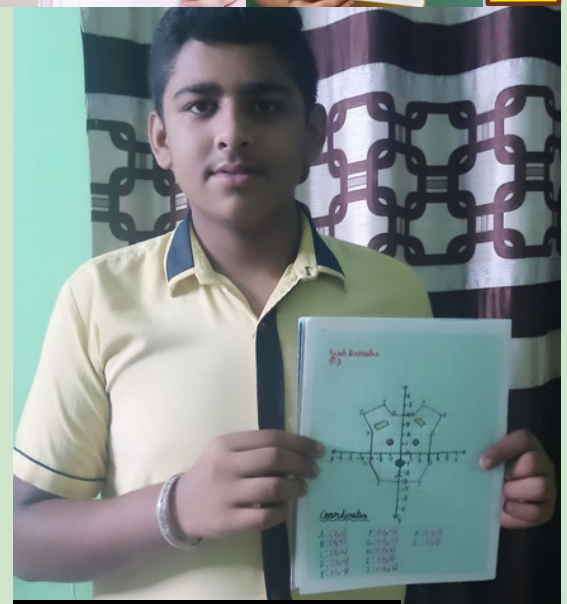

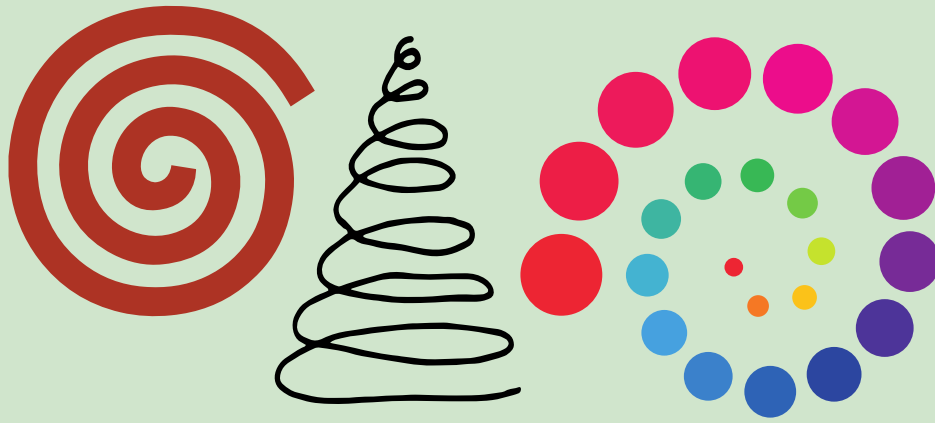


Mathematics expresses itself everywhere, in almost every facet of life- in nature all around us and in the technology in our hands. Mathematics develops computational skills, critical thinking and problem solving skills. Vandana International School recognizes this and strives to ensure that the students obtain this knowledge.



The students of class IX, under the guidance of their teachers, learnt about Coordinate Geometry through an activity of designing figures on the graph sheet. They participated in high spirits and were able to enhance their knowledge about the concept of coordinate geometry by marking the coordinates of the points on the graph. 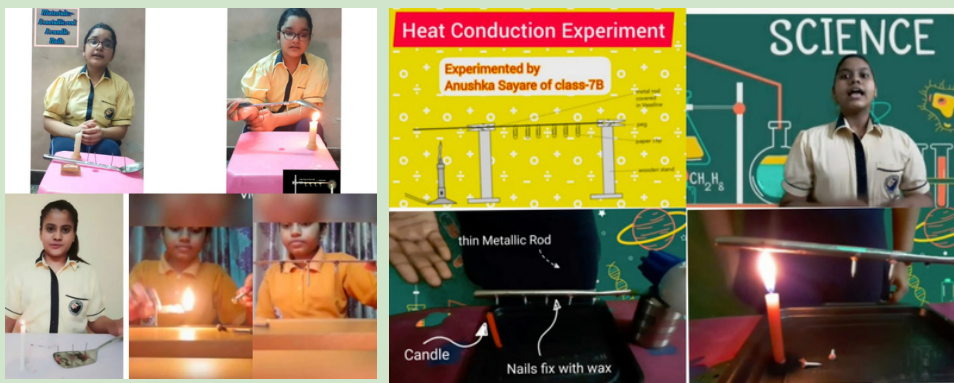

Students of class 9 used the spiral method to gain better understanding of the number system and to find the square root of 2,3,4,5,..... 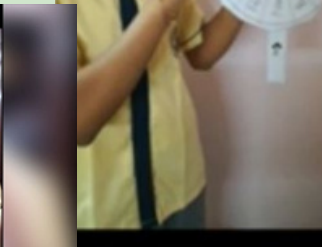
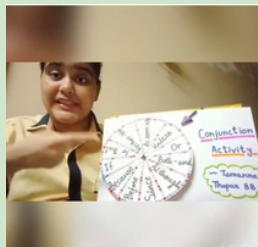
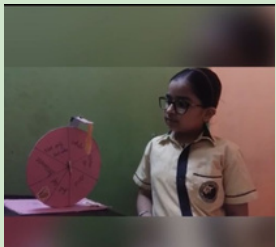
The English Department of VIS reverberates that Subject Enrichment Activities are an integral part of our pedagogy as well as assessment.
